During this iBEDSMA symposium a 'Free Papers' sessions will be organised allowing Oral Communications of abstracts in the field of Dental and Surgical Sleep Medicine to be presented by you and your colleagues to the iBEDSMA audience. A multidisciplinary Jury will select the best Oral Presentation during the session (Friday afternoon) and on Saturday this author will receive the **'iBEDSMA Award for best oral presentation' (value 1.000,00 €).**

The instructions for the abstracts are as follows:

- Abstracts should be submitted in the English language.
- Provide all authors names and underline the presenting author's name.
- Organize the body of the abstract as follows: Title, authors, introduction, aims, material and methods, results, conclusions; for case reports replace "material and methods" by "Case report"
- a maximum of one figure or table is allowed
- use a font 12 of any lettertype in MS Word
- the abstract cannot exceed the one page A4 (with exception of the space required for the Table or Figure)
- presentations need to in English and the presenting author must be iBEDSMA member at the time of presentation of his/her paper
