Final Announcement FIRST HYBRID iBEDSSMA SYMPOSIUM

Dear Colleague

It is with great pleasure that iBEDSSMA confirms the final program of its first ever “Hybrid meeting” that will take place on 10.10.2020.

Physical attendance will be possible to ALL attendees. This will evidently also allow participants to collect accreditation units if they cannot subscribe to online postgraduate courses. While all interested colleagues are welcome on the spot at the venue in Berchem, others might be interested to follow the symposium online. The latter will also lead to a certificate of attendance and, if applicable, accreditation points. Please note that for those that will attend physically, the social distancing rules will be strictly supervised and that therefore the number of attendees who may physically attend, may be limited. A “first come, first serve” policy applies.

The lectures will be live-streamed simultaneously for those participants that have timely registered. These will also be provided with a link that allows active participation. The program will offer a state-of-the-art discussion on post-COVID-19 starting-up practices related to OSA treatment, with contributions by diagnosing sleep physicians, ENT-surgeons, maxillofacial surgeons and dental sleep specialists. This will be followed by a keynote lecture on the epidemiology of COVID-19 by one of our Belgian experts in the field: Professor Pierre Van Damme from University of Antwerp. A round table on the topic to discuss pertinent questions will follow the lectures.

The program will also offer an insight in new techniques in prediction and preselection of patients for surgical OSA treatment, as well as in the follow-up of oral appliance therapy.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic the membership fee will now last for 18 months, until the end of December 2021. This extended membership fee amounts 125 euro. Please register on the website: <http://ibedssma.be/portal/member-registration/>.
